Edge firmness comparison

Power Edge® Bonnell Coil



A tighter turn, or convolute, in the interior of the coil adds greater support.



A straighter angle to the wire coming off the knotted area adds firmness to Power Edge® coils.

Standard Bonnell Coil



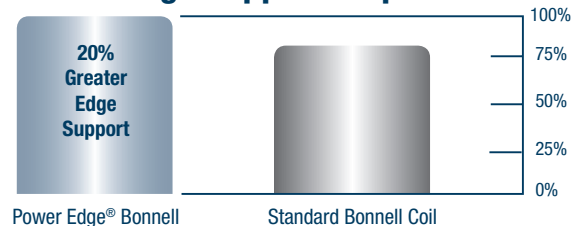
Standard Bonnell coil has a larger inner convolute, making the coil softer and not as supportive.



Standard Bonnell coils are formed with a curved arch coming out of the knotted area, making the coil less firm.

When depressed, the Power Edge® Bonnell innerspring unit gives you 20% gain in edge firmness over our standard Bonnell units.
